

Protection of Personal Information Act (POPIA) Compliance Statement

The NHKA Malelane (hereinafter referred to as “NHKA”) is committed to protecting your personal information and ensuring that your privacy is respected. This document outlines our compliance with the Protection of Personal Information Act (POPIA) and provides an overview of how we collect, process, and safeguard your information.

1. Personal Information We Collect

NHKA may collect the following types of personal information from you:

- Name and surname
- Contact details (e.g., phone number, email address)
- Residential or postal address
- Information required for event participation or community projects
- Financial details (where necessary, e.g., for donations)

2. Purpose of Collecting Personal Information

We collect and process your personal information for the following purposes:

- To communicate with you regarding church events, services, and activities.
- To provide updates about sermons, projects, and announcements.
- To manage event registrations and bookings.
- To comply with legal and regulatory obligations.

3. Your Rights as a Data Subject

Under POPIA, you have the following rights:

- The right to access your personal information held by NHKA.
- The right to request correction or deletion of inaccurate or unnecessary information.
- The right to withdraw consent where processing is based on your consent.
- The right to object to the processing of personal information in certain circumstances.

4. Security of Your Information

NHKA implements appropriate technical and organizational measures to protect your personal information from unauthorized access, loss, or misuse. These measures include:

- Secure storage systems
- Access controls and password protection
- Regular monitoring and updates to our data protection systems

5. Sharing of Personal Information

NHKA does not sell or rent your personal information to third parties. We may share information with trusted service providers only when necessary for:

- Managing our website or online communication systems.
- Organizing church functions or activities.

All third parties are required to handle your data in compliance with POPIA.

6. Retention of Personal Information

Personal information is retained only for as long as it is necessary to fulfill the purposes outlined above or to comply with legal obligations.
